- Alert EX holders to the UN6(d)- unconfined package test required for UN0349, UN0367, UN0384 and UN0481

PHMSA Process

- Explosives Portal Search – Looked for “UN6(d)” in the notes section of the latest version of the approval.
- **2211** EX Numbers were obtained from the search



PHMSA Process

- **ALL** Holders must submit an application for a modification iaw 107.709
- Options-
 - Up-class, provide basis
 - UN#
 - Proper shipping name
 - Compatibility Group
 - Provide UN6(d) test results from Explosives lab or foreign CA
 - Request to terminate



PHMSA Process

- What if I have UN6(d) test results that were already submitted to PHMSA and the UN6(d) note, **“This classification meets UN 6(d) criteria.”**- Does not appear on my approval?

Submit a modification request to add the UN6(d) note and supply a copy of the lab report.



Individual letters

- Individual EX holders will receive an email within the next two weeks.
- Holders with more than 30 approvals will be provided an Excel[®] spread sheet listing EX numbers involved.



Alerting Members

- PHMSA is looking for your help to alert your members to the requirement
- PHMSA's list is not all inclusive



April 10, 2021

- Action required by April 10, 2021
- What if the holder does not act?



Federal Register Notice

- A Federal Register Notice, “Show Cause” listing those EX numbers still outstanding, will be issued early in 2021, with the intent to terminate.



Act Early

- Act Early-
 - Contact explosive lab if UN6(d) testing is required,
 - Send in a modification request as early as possible,
 - retain 1.4S 6(d) testing required
 - Up-class 1.4 other than S
 - Terminate
